Our focus will be the Guild's Permanent Collection, which contains more than 450 works, dating from the early 1900's to the present day of Inuit and First Nation prints, sculptures, and artifacts. Diana Perera the Guilds Coordinator and specialist in Inuit art, will give us an oral presentation and then guide us through the Permanent Collection. We plan to finish at the Guild by 11:45. There is no fee for the visit (the Guild is a non-profit organization) but donations to their Permanent Collection Fund would always be welcome.

Unfortunately the space at the Guild is limited to 15 participants for this visit but other visits can be organized if more are interested.

The cost of the lunch at Restaurant Nococho is up to the individual but will be about \$10 on average.
